COURSE GOAL:

To embrace basic legal concepts in the field of healthcare legislation. To get familiar with the laws, ordinances, regulations and other legal acts that regulate the work of health professionals, health activities and patients' rights. Familiarize students with legal aspects of healthcare work environment. Developing professional awareness, responsibility, humanity, sense of deontology.

COURSE OUTCOME:

Upon completion of the course Legal Aspects in Healthcare, the student is expected to acquire basic knowledge related to:

- Defining the basic concepts of health legislation
- Acquiring knowledge related to the legal significance of adequate keeping of health documentation and records
- Acquiring knowledge about the rights of patients, their duties and the protection of their rights
- Getting to know the responsibilities of healthcare professionals and associates

EVALUATION:

SEMINAR ESSAYS: In this way, the student can earn up to 20 points. Each student receives a topic for a seminar essays in each module that he/she submits in written form. The preparation, content and form of the seminar paper are evaluated. A list of topics for seminar papers will be offered to students in the first term of the course.

EVALUATION OF THE SEMINAR: In this way, the student can earn up to 20 points. Preparedness, manner of presentation, inclusion of others in the discussion are evaluated. The list of topics for clinical seminars will be offered to students in the first term of the course (one seminar can be prepared by one or more students).

FINAL TEST: In this way, the student can earn up to 60 points.

The final grade is formed as follows:

In order to pass the course, the student must obtain a minimum of 51 points.

To pass the course the student must:

1. acquires more than 50% of the points provided for the activity
2. pass the final exam, i.e. have more than 50% correct answers on the final test.
